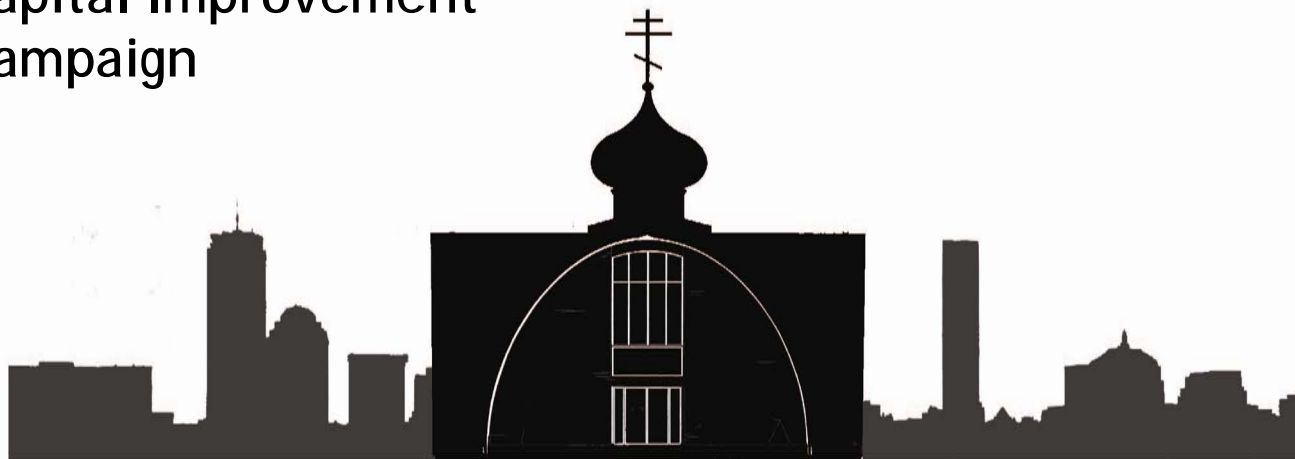


Centennial 2010 Capital Improvement Campaign
